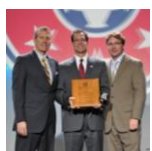

Camp Director – Scott Reitnour: In Reitnour's 15-year tenure at Wesleyan Christian Academy, the Men of Troy have posted a 284-48-32 record (398-93-50 overall), captured 9 PACIS Conference Titles, enjoyed 9 state finals appearances, won 6 state championships (05, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17), recorded 42 and 62-match winning streaks & been ranked as high as #1 in the country in four different seasons. Coach Reitnour was selected to coach in the 2012 HS All-American game; served 5 years as NCISAA 3A Boys Soccer chair; earned recognition as PACIS COY 8 times; NCSCA 3A Private School Regional COY 6 times; NC State COY 6 times; NSCAA South Regional COY 3 times & been a finalist for NSCAA National COY 3 times. Reitnour holds his NSCAA National & Advanced National Diplomas & has helped over seventy players move on to enjoy outstanding professional and college careers. Reitnour coaches with Piedmont Triad Football Club, where he earned recognition as NSCAA Mondo Atlantic Regional COY and was a finalist for NSCAA/Mondo National COY in 2009. Reitnour led the *Kings Warriors* to a second place conference finish and the PDL Fair Play award in 2014. Reitnour also founded *Imago Dei Soccer Academy*, a technique & agility school for competitive soccer players & goalkeepers.

Kevin Barrows – Varsity Men's Assistant Coach: Kevin Barrows serves as a history teacher and JV Boys Soccer Coach at WCA. Barrows has served the program for 24 years, taking on various roles, including head coach, assistant coach, head JV coach and middle school coach. He is the winningest coach in the history of WCA Soccer, and he has modeled excellence at every level the coaching continuum. Barrows has coached numerous state championship and nationally ranked Wesleyan soccer teams, and he has sent numerous players on to the collegiate and professional soccer ranks. In 2008 and 2009, Coach Barrows was named NCSCA Private School Assistant Coach of the Year, and in 2012 Barrows was named NSCAA National Assistant Coach of the Year. Coach Barrows enjoyed success coaching premier teams in the NCYSA from 1991-1999. In 1998, Barrows was named NCYSA Boys coach of the year, while coaching with Piedmont Soccer Alliance.



Jennifer Ludemann – Trevecca Nazarine: Jennifer Ludemann graduated from Wesleyan Christian Academy in 2009. During her spectacular career at Wesleyan she received numerous honors including All-Conference, All-Region and All-State selections. She attended and played at the UNC Wilmington where she helped lead the team to their first-ever CAA conference championship. She was a 4 year starter, 2 year captain and a Strength and Conditioning All-American at UNCW. After graduating college she continued to play professionally in Finland for 2 seasons as a starter and captain. She then returned stateside and played 2 seasons with the Charlotte Lady Eagles. She has coached club soccer with Charlotte Soccer Academy, and she currently coaches at Trevecca Nazarine.



Carter Robbins – Imago Dei Academy Director: During his tenure as a player at Wesleyan Christian Academy Carter Robbins served as team captain & earned All-PACIS and All-State honors. Carter also captained his state finalist PTFC 92 Premier Black team. Carter was a 4-year starter for the Kings Warriors in the Premier Development League of the USL. During his time at Messiah College, Robbins was a 3-year starter. In 2012, he was named First Team All-American by D3Soccer.com, First Team All-Region by the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) & First Team All-Conference. In 2013, Robbins earned Academic All-Conference honors, was selected as an NSCAA All-American and won his 2nd consecutive NCAA National Championship! In 2014, Carter earned NSCAA 1st team All-American honors. Carter joined the Wesleyan staff in 2015 and is the current Imago Dei Academy Director!



Harry Sherwood – Varsity Girls Soccer Coach & Assistant Boys Coach: Harry Sherwood serves as the Varsity Girls Soccer Coach & Varsity Boys Assistant Coach at Wesleyan. In 2012 and 2017 Harry was named NCSCA Regional Assistant COY and NCSCA State Assistant COY. Harry joins WCA from Bristol, England. Harry has served as an Assistant Coach for the Kings Warriors (PDL), as a head coach for Piedmont Triad Football Club, and as a technical instructor for Imago Dei Soccer Academy. Harry played in the PDL for the Kings Warriors (2012, 13 & 14) and participated in Bridges to the Pros, Chicago (2011). Harry served as the captain of the Kings Warriors side, led the team in goals and played every minute of every game in 2012. Sherwood played four years of college soccer at Bryan College (2008 – 2011), and served as captain during his junior and senior campaigns. As a Sophomore, Sherwood earned 1st Team All-AAC honors, led Bryan to the AAC Conference championship and the NAIA National Tournament. As a Junior, Sherwood earned AAC POY and 1st Team All-Conference honors, as he led Bryan to the AAC Regular Season Championship, AAC Tournament Championship, into the NAIA Sweet 16 and a final national ranking of #9 in the country.



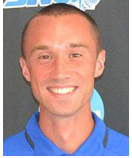
Lauren Sherwood – Varsity Girls Soccer Coach & PTFC Head Coach 02 White: Lauren Sherwood teaches in the Resource & Enrichment center at WCA and serves as the Varsity Girls Soccer Coach at Wesleyan. Lauren played four years of Varsity Girls Soccer at Parkwood High School in Waxhaw, NC where she led them to Union County Conference Championships in 2005 & 2006 and a state quarterfinal appearance in 2006. Lauren played college soccer at Bryan College in Dayton, TN from 2008-2012. With the Bryan Lions, Lauren earned First Team All-AAC honors in 2010 and 2012. Lauren also played with the Chicago Eagles (2009-2010). In addition to coaching and playing, Lauren has led overseas mission tours with the Charlotte Eagles from 2012- present. She has also led International Tours with Imago Dei Soccer Academy.



Corbin Waller – Varsity Boys Goalkeeper Coach: Corbin has served as the goalkeeper coach for the WCA Varsity Boys Soccer Team. In addition to his duties at Wesleyan, Corbin has served as a head coach with PTFC, and he currently serves as a goalkeeper instructor with Imago Dei Soccer Academy. Corbin Waller played youth soccer with the PSA Stars before going on to play four years of Division 1 college soccer at the College of Charleston. As the starting goalkeeper in 2006, Corbin led the Southern Conference in total saves (87); was second in saves per game (4.35); earned 9 shutouts, and was named 2nd team All-South NSCAA. Waller signed with Houston Dynamo (MLS) in 2008. In 2009, Waller joined the Charlotte Eagles (USL) where he kept a clean sheet in his professional debut against the Real Maryland Monarchs. Corbin coached and ran camp programs with the Charlotte Eagles and was an integral member of the Urban Eagles ministry program.



Garrett Bireline – Southern Wesleyan University Head Men’s Soccer Coach:



Garrett Bireline currently serves as the Head Men’s Soccer Coach at Southern Wesleyan University. Bireline served as an assistant at Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis for two seasons before joining the SWU staff. Bireline helped develop 5 All-Summit league performers, 3 Summit League All-Newcomer nominees, one 2014 Academic All-Summit League recipient, and helped to develop a player that now plays professionally for St. Louis FC. Prior to coaching at IUPUI, Bireline was an assistant coach at Wheaton College in Illinois for two seasons. He helped the Thunder to back-to-back CCIW conference crowns and consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances. In just two seasons, he coached two All-Americans, nine All-Region and 13 All-Conference performers, while compiling a 35-8-5 record. Bireline also has experience with the Strikers Fox Valley Soccer Club of St. Charles, Ill., and experience with the Chicago Eagles, a division of Missionary Athletes International (MAI). Bireline played 4 seasons collegiately at Bowling Green State University, and he received his M.S. in Sports Management from Liberty University in 2014.

Luke Sanford – Indiana Wesleyan University Head Men’s Soccer Coach:



Luke Sanford currently serves as the Head Men’s Soccer coach at Indiana Wesleyan University. Sanford led the Wildcats to the program’s best ever finish at the NAIA National Championship in 2015 as the team advanced to the national quarterfinals. Before coaching at IWU, Sanford served as an assistant coach Nyack College in New York, NY and as an assistant coach at Point Loma Nazarene (Calif.). Sanford has also served a coaching intern with the Charlotte Eagles, as an assistant coach with Southern WV Kings Warriors in the USL Premier Development League, and he coached club soccer with the Charlotte Soccer Academy and Surf Soccer Club. Sanford played soccer in the NAIA at Houghton (N.Y.) and also played for the Mississippi Brilla in the PDL. Sanford played club soccer for the PSA Stars and high school soccer for Wesleyan Christian Academy; he graduated from WCA in 2005.

Jeremy Payne – Eastern University Head Men’s Soccer Coach:



Jeremy serves as the Head Men’s Soccer Coach at Eastern University. Prior to becoming Head Coach, Payne served as an assistant at Eastern for two seasons. Payne played collegiately at perennial powerhouse Messiah College. In four years with the Falcons, Payne won two National Championships, was a three-time First-Team All-American (NSCAA & D3Soccer), was named the D3Soccer Midfielder of the Year twice, D3Soccer Forward of the Year once and NSCAA National Player of the Year in both 2012 and 2014. Payne also played in the PDL with the Southern West Virginia King’s Warriors. Payne was also a member of the MAC Academic All-Conference team in 2013, 2014. Payne’s coaching experience includes working the Messiah College and U.S. Naval Academy soccer camps for four years as well as coaching the Mechanicsburg Middle School junior high boys soccer team. He also coaches club soccer at Penn Fusion.
